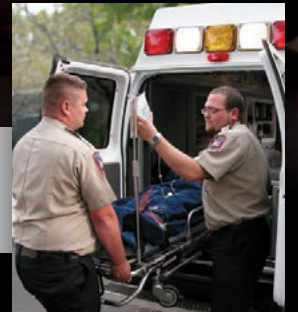

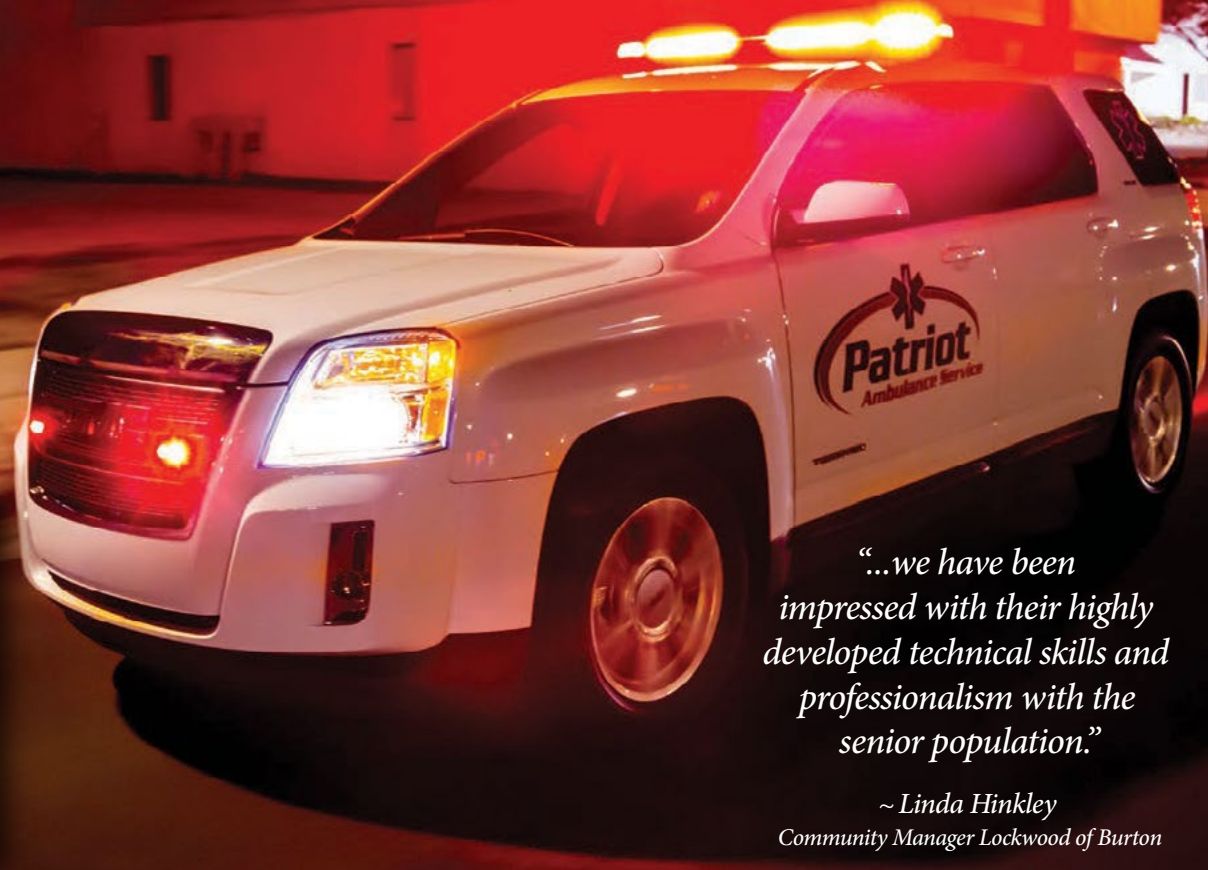

TRAINING

The CCEMTPSM Program has been completely redesigned to meet the current needs of the critical care transport provider working in ground, air or fixed wing environments. The new curriculum focuses on advanced level knowledge and assumes that participants come in with a working knowledge of chemistry, pharmacodynamics, along with anatomy & physiology. The curriculum is truly one that creates a Specialty Care Transport Provider and has been not only 100% peer reviewed by leaders in the industry, but also 100% physician reviewed." -University of Maryland Baltimore County

COST

The cost to implement this program at your facility is...absolutely nothing! With no cost to train, equip, or staff any aspect of our CCT program, hospitals now have a cost effective means of moving seriously ill patients. Helicopter transports easily exceed \$10,000 per flight. This program provides patients with the same level of care at a fraction of the cost!

SPEED

Unlike air based services, Patriot's CCT Team is not bound by low flight visibility or bad weather. In most cases we can provide a safer, faster, and cheaper alternative to flight services while providing the same level of care. Our Critical Care Paramedics are trained through the University of Maryland in the only nationally recognized critical care transport program. Our staff has been trained by the very same educators that train air ambulance services already utilized by hospitals all over the nation.

THE TEAM

Our team is staffed with carefully selected individuals. Training, education, experience, and high acuity patient performance, are all requirements of our CCT Team. The CCT team consists of an EMT or Paramedic to drive, a Critical Care Paramedic supervise and treat the patient, and when needed a second paramedic to assist with patient care. We only consider applicants with the highest level of quality and experience. Simply obtaining a critical care certification does not grant an individual a spot on our team.

CAPABILITIES

Critical Care Transport capabilities include:

- Ventilator Operation
- Invasive line monitoring
- Blood infusion and transport
- IV medications including thrombolytics, vasopressors, antidysrhythmics, etc.
- Capnography
- Rapid Sequence Intubation
